On July 22nd, the Chapter held Patriots Pride Day at Veterans Memorial Park in Middletown, Frederick County. The day long event featured a variety of patriotic and memorial events, food vendors and local exhibitors, Continental and British Army Encampments and featured a battle reenactment with all muskets blazing.

The Chapter received considerable publicity before and after the event with 4 newspaper articles and a 2 minute TV spot on Local-DMV TV based in Hagerstown, Md.

The event started with a ceremony featuring a parade of Color Guards and then a presentation by the National Sojourners. The visitors toured the encampments and talked with the re-enactors who numbered over forty! The highlight of the day was the Battle of Middletowne where the Middletown Home Guard faced off against the British 4th Company of Guards.

French & Indian War Foundation Member Patrick Murphy



Our speaker at the June General Meeting was French & Indian War Foundation Board Member and Chapter Member Patrick Murphy.

Compatriot Murphy is the author of *F&I War: Life on the Inner Frontier* 1752-1766.

His presentation entitled: *The French & Indian War: From Memory and Artifacts* covered many seldom explored areas of the conflict using maps, diary entries, official records, legends and known artifacts of the era.

He also recounts the reaction of the local residents in reaction to the British Army under General Braddock passing through area and the subsequent rise of Col. George Washington to command the army and become the protector of the western frontier of the colonies.
